The position is on 14 days "onsite" and 14 days "offsite" rotation at the Voisey's Bay Nickel Mine located in Labrador. The duration of the position is temporary with a duration of 6-12 months.

General Duties associated with an operating mine site services include but not limited to the following:

- General clean up underground in conjunction with Vale's 5S (sort, set in order, shine, standardize, and sustain)
- Visit various site locations to clean, organize, inventory, and dispose of items/materials
- Organize objects into items to be kept versus to be discarded. Identify proper location for items
- Labelling objects
- Painting up red zones
- There may be other associated duties with regards to site services work at a mine site including general labourer duties, aircraft loading/offloading, cargo loading/offloading, etc.
