TSI is currently seeking qualified candidates for the following fly-in/fly out position.

LEVEL 2 Maintenance Technician – Carpenter (Competition # 2025-002)

The position is on 14 days "onsite" and 14 days "offsite" rotation at the Voisey's Bay Nickel Mine located in Labrador.

Duties include but not limited to the operation of the following:

- Routine maintenance and corrective maintenance on current facilities
- Carpentry works such as framing, plastering, tiling, taper, and finishing
- Review blueprints, sketches and building plans to prepare project layout and determine dimension and materials
- Actively participate in the planning process to ensure that the right work is being completed at the right time with the right resources
- Be involved in root cause analysis, problem solving, and troubleshooting in area of responsibility
- Maintain complete and accurate records of shift logs and inspections
- Working apart of a Maintenance Team alongside with Electricians and Plumbers
- Adhered to Provincial Health and Safety Regulations and onsite policies and procedures

Other general duties associated with an operating mine Site Services include aircraft offloading, cargo handling, and other related support activities
